Varicose § Spider Veins

Varicose veins are enlarged, "ropey" veins that appear on the surface of the skin on your legs, although they can sometimes hide below the skin as well. Spider veins are smaller, unsightly veins often associated with varicose veins. Proper diagnosis and treatment of these veins leads to rapid relief of symptoms and cosmetic improvement.

Leg Pain, Swelling or Ulcers

LEG PAIN, SWELLING, AND THEIR ADVANCED COUSIN – LEG ULCERS – ARE COMMON PROBLEMS IN BOTH WOMEN AND MEN.

A frequent cause is Venous Insufficiency, or poorly working veins in the legs. This is the same problem that underlies varicose veins, but in this case without the visible veins. This condition is often associated with an old blood clot (chronic DVT) or sometimes a narrowing of veins in the pelvis called May-Thurner Syndrome. Anyone with unexplained leg pain, swelling or leg ulcers should be properly assessed by a physician.

We are able to evaluate, diagnose and treat these problems right in our office. When necessary, we can perform intravascular ultrasound (placing a tiny ultrasound probe inside the vein) to evaluate for May-Thurner Syndrome, as well as insert stents in the veins to improve blood flow using our in-office cath lab. These are fast, simple procedures with little to no downtime.

Peripheral artery disease (PAD) is a common circulatory problem occurring when fatty deposits (plague) build up along the wall of an artery, causing a progressive thickening of the artery's lining, causing the artery to narrow, which then restricts, or even blocks, blood flow.

This problem is often more severe when it occurs along with diabetes or high blood pressure.

SYMPTOMS

Not all fibroids cause symptoms, but when they do, these symptoms may include:

EXTREMELY HEAVY PERIODS AND CRAMPING

LOWER BACK PAIN

PAINFUL SEXUAL INTERCOURSE

URGE TO URINATE FREQUENTLY

PAIN WITH DEFECATION

Uterine fibroids, sometimes called "fibroid tumors" are benign masses that grow in the wall of the uterus. Although no one knows exactly what causes fibroids, they do know that the female hormones estrogen and progesterone seem to make them grow.

The recommended treatment is called Uterine Fibroid Embolization (UFE). which Dr. Gropper performs in our state-of-the-art cath lab

Pelvic Congestion Syndrome

Pelvic Congestion Syndrome is a chronic condition where women experience constant and chronic pelvic pain due to the development of varicose veins in the pelvic area. These varicose veins typically appear during pregnancy and continue to progress in size.

SYMPTOMS

- **A DULL ACHE AGGRAVATED BY STANDING**
- ✓ PAIN CAN BE WORSE AT THE END OF THE DAY, DURING/AFTER SEXUAL INTERCOURSE AND/OR BEFORE THE ONSET OF MENSTRUATION
- VAGINAL DISCHARGE

- MENSTRUAL CYCLE DEFECTS
- ABDOMINAL BLOATING

TREATMENT

Dr. Gropper's preferred treatment for Pelvic Congestion Syndrome is called Ovarian Vein Embolization. The goal of this minimally invasive treatment is to shut down the problematic veins so blood doesn't collect in the pelvis, thereby relieving pressure and pain.

As men age, they often begin to experience urinary issues that can cause embarrassment, loss of sleep, and more. Prostate artery embolization (PAE) is a new treatment option for men with an enlarged prostate gland that often causes the urinary issues.

TREATMENT

During the PAE procedure, Dr. Gropper inserts a tiny catheter into the femoral artery and guides it to the prostate artery on both sides of the enlarged prostate gland. Once positioned next to the prostate, the catheter is used to deliver microscopic spheres to block blood flow, causing the prostate to shrink, and dramatically reducing symptoms.

GastroBloc for Obesity

Gastric Artery Embolization – or the GastroBloc – is a safe and effective nonsurgical weight loss procedure created to suppress ghrelin, an appetite-stimulating hormone created in the stomach. Rising levels of ghrelin are one reason that people have trouble sticking with a diet.



TREATMENT

Dr. Gropper performs the Gastric Artery Embolization procedure by injecting microscopic beads into the bloodstream. The beads make their way to the artery supplying the upper part of the stomach, where they block the smaller vessels and interfere with ghrelin production. This is all accomplished through a minimally invasive non-surgical technique through a small catheter inserted in the wrist or groin.
